Fight for \$15 campaign petition drive

VANCOUVER – A petition drive for the Fight for \$15 Campaign will take place at a variety of locations in Vancouver, Burnaby and Victoria January 15.

The B.C. Federation of Labour launched the Fight for \$15 Campaign to increase the minimum wage in BC to \$15 an hour. The Campaign sponsors events on the 15th of each month, highlighting a unique aspect of the Campaign. In January, the focus is students and the minimum wage.

“We know that many students are struggling to put themselves through school and make ends meet on minimum wage jobs,” said Irene Lanzinger, President of the B.C. Federation of Labour. “Post-secondary graduates are leaving school with an average of \$35,000 of debt. That is not good for our young people, and not good for the economy.”
